

## **COVID-19 vaccination**

<u>Saturday Aug 14<sup>i</sup></u>	<u>Midden Peelweg 4B MAASBREE (MHP Maasbree; Kafra)</u>	<u>12:00 -20:00</u>

<sup>1</sup> Aug 14: second vaccination Pfizer for those who were vaccinated with their first Pfizer on July 3, 9 & 10. This day it is also possible for you to get a Pfizer vaccine if you aren't vaccinated yet.

***You can get vaccinated there with the Janssen or Pfizer vaccine.***

### **Important to know**

The following is important to know beforehand:

1. The decision to get vaccinated is your personal decision. Your employer is not allowed to know if you do (or do not) want a vaccination, or if you are vaccinated.
2. If you do not understand any of the information, please ask your colleague, friend or employer for help. Again: the final decision to get vaccinated is your personal decision. Your employer or someone else cannot force you to get vaccinated.

### **Which vaccine will I get?**

You can choose between Pfizer and Janssen. Pfizer requires two appointments. There needs to be at least 5 weeks between appointment 1 and appointment 2.

Janssen requires only 1 appointment. Pfizer offers slightly better protection against the coronavirus than Janssen.

### **How to make a vaccination appointment**

To get a vaccination appointment use the QR-CODE and go to our special website for migrant workers to register for a vaccination. This is offered in multiple languages.

- You will receive email with a location, date and time of your vaccination.
- Fill out your health statement (enclosed in various languages), and take the filled in form with you to your appointment
- Go to the vaccination location on the specific date and time. A vaccine is reserved for you, so it is very important to be there on time.

#### **Important to remember for your appointment**

- Wear a face mask.
- Wear clothes that make it easy to uncover your upper arm.
- Bring along the completed list of health questions.
- Bring along your ID and your BSN number.
- Come alone if you can. If you need help, you may bring someone with you.
